Youth Development in AgriLife Task Force

August 2021 Update

Their charge was to develop an Options Report regarding the future organization and administration of youth development academic and extension programs in AgriLife. The task force has identified four options to meet this respective Charge. The second deliverable was to inventory existing youth development programs and associated faculty and specialists within the College, AgriLife Research, Texas A&M Forest Service and AgriLife Extension. The task force identified over 345 existing youth development programs or events collectively offered by AgriLife within the contextual areas of health living, STEM, livestock, leadership, and many others.
